The enthusiastic response led to 'Gharana' becoming an annual festival of Hindustani classical music held at the Museum Theatre, in March. In the earlier years, Fahimuddin Dagar, Hindustani instrumental musician Pt Dhruba Ghosh, sarod musician Rajeev Taranath, Sruti Sadholikar and flautist Nityanad Haldirpur have performed at this show. This year, the line-up includes:

March 23, 7 pm: Hindustani instrumental music on the sitar by Irshad Khan with Rudra Narayan Kalyan on tabla

March 24, 7 pm: Hindustani instrumental with a shehnai concert by Pt Krishna Ram Choudhary, Hemant Raj Choudhary, Sumit on tabla, Vivek on harmonium, Deepak on swarpetti and Mangal Prasad on dukkad

March 25, 7 pm: Hindustani vocal by Shanno Khurana, Akhtar Hasan on tabla, Bharat Bhushan Goswami on sarangi and Maitreyi Majumdar on swaramandal.
